Please also keep in mind that many of the venues that we are scheduled to go to are requiring payment and number of attendees at a minimum of two weeks in advance. There is no refund if our number decreases and that is money the program loses. Please note: ALL CHANGES IN SCHEDULE MUST BE DONE SOLEY THROUGH THE OFFICE TWO WEEKS IN ADVANCE OR YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COST OF THE FIELDTRIP TUITION FOR THE DAY EVEN IF YOUR CHILD DOES NOT ATTEND. Giving a verbal notification to the day camp staff will not count as giving notice. It MUST be changed by the office on your original Registration application. Please look at your schedule carefully. Field trips fill up quickly and we will be limited to the capacity of the Busses. After that fills, children will be placed on a waiting list for Thursday field trips. We have also updated our Payment Tuition Agreement which has Bi-Weekly Payment dates scheduled. All tuition will be billed out 2 weeks in advance and sent to the email provided on the application. Look for the new tuition agreement on the Summer Application. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

This year we will be offering a friends and family referral program. Every new family that signs up for camp this year and puts you as a referral will earn you \$50 credit towards your camp fees. So, spread the word! Camp will start on June 9th and run through August 8th.
